After obtaining MSS in Sociology from the University of Dhaka, Dr Mahbuba has received **Commonwealth Scholarship** for pursuing her PhD Degree from Massey University, New Zealand and developed a pioneering grounded theory in the field of Gender and Disaster. She has been awarded with the scholarships from primary education to higher studies level including **President Award** for achieving **4th position in the combined merit list** (Humanities Group) in Higher Secondary Certificate from Dhaka Board and **Chancellor Award** for securing **First Class First Position** in BSS (Honours) examination (Sociology), University of Dhaka. As an award winning debater she is also the Moderator of Dhaka University Debating Society (DUDS).

Professor Dr Mahbuba Nasreen received **Mary Fran Myers Award, 2016** from the Natural Hazards Centre, University of Colorado (Boulder), USA for her three-decade long outstanding contributions in the field of Disaster and Gender studies.
